Report on Plastic free campus

Regional college of Management Bangalore made an Awareness program on a Plastic Free Campus. We aim to measurably reduce plastic waste and pollution in our campus and the world around us on September 16th 2021

To achieve this, we have undertaken following steps:

1. Regional college of Management Bangalore has banned use of single-use plastics in canteens
2. In regular intervals, we carry out awareness drives and sensitization workshops on the harmful impacts of single-use plastics.
3. Encourage all students to avoid bringing non-bio-degradable plastic items to the campus.
4. We encourage students to sensitize their respective households about the harmful effects of plastics and make their households also 'plastic-free'.
5. We have installed necessary alternative facilities like water units to avoid the use of plastic water bottles, and encourage the use of alternative solutions like cloth bags, paper bags, etc, instead of plastic bottles, bags, cover, and other goods on campus.

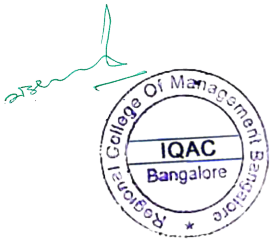
