### Outcomes of the Campaign

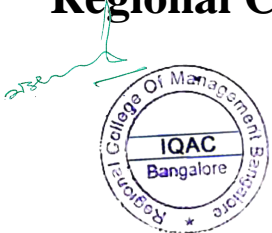

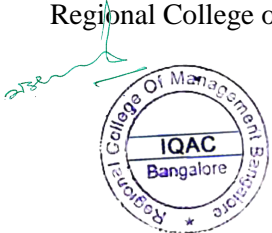
## REPORT ON PLASTIC FREE CAMPAIGN

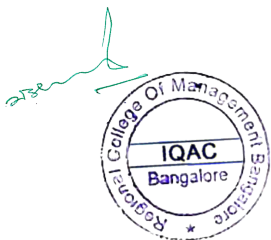

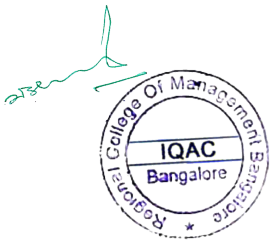

The main objective of this Blood Donation camp is to save lives and improve the health of patients in need.

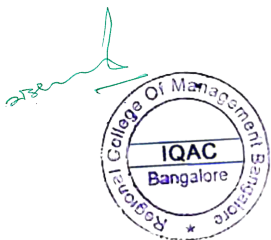
