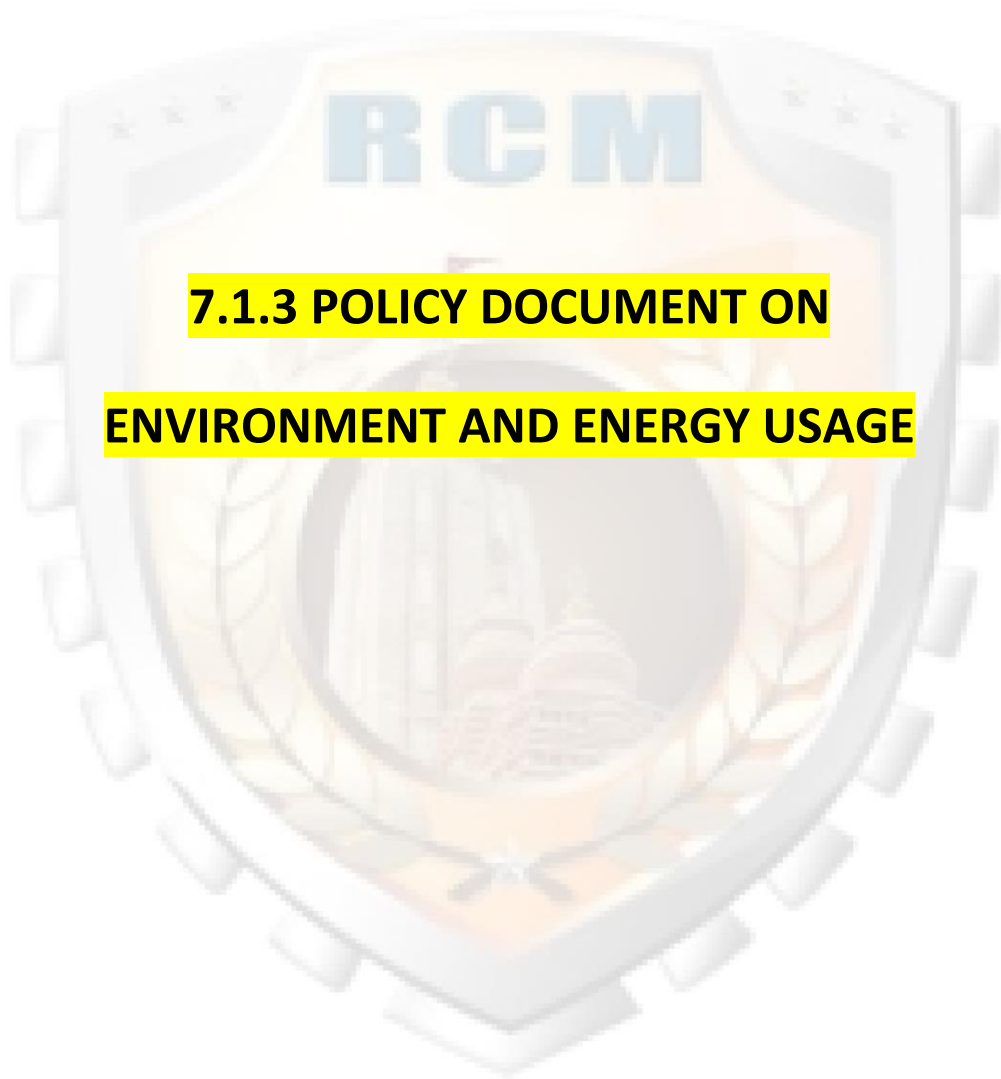




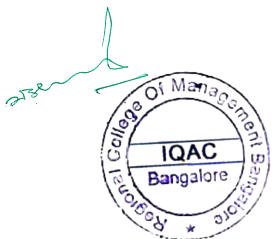

Policy Document on Environment and Energy Usage

Green Camus Committee, is dedicated to environmental awareness, green initiatives, and to conduct green literacy programmes in order to conserve energy and safeguard the environment.

Policies:

1. To assess our energy usage and measure its impact on the environment.
2. To count CO2 emissions generated by our means of transportations - vehicles
3. To reduce local air pollution emissions using environmental – friendly vehicles, including bicycles public transportation and use of pedestrian-friendly roads
4. To install solar panels for the generation of alternate energy
5. To install LED bulbs in the complete campus to save energy.
6. To develop systematic waste management mechanism.
7. To develop rain water harvesting unit.
8. To undertake tree plantation drive
9. To take additional measures to continuously improve our energy consumption.
10. To encourage use of advanced technology to minimize energy consumption, atmospheric emissions and noise, particularly from our vehicle fleets.

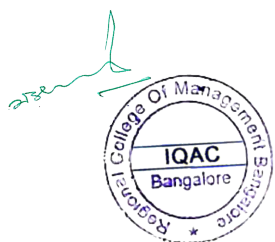
